Vaccine	Nobilis° CAV P4 is a live attenuated vaccine against Chicken Anaemia Virus (CAV)
Target Species	Chicken Breeders
Composition	Active Components: CAV virus living, attenuated strain 26P4 with \geq 3.0 log10 TCID50 per dose
Formulation	Freeze-dried pellet
Indications	For protection of chicken progeny against CAV disease by immunisation of breeders.
Disease	CAV is a small, hardy virus that causes anaemia, lymphoid depletion of the thymus, immune suppression and consequent secondary infections with other viruses, bacteria, fungi and protozoans. The disease and its secondary complications in young chickens are prevented by vaccination of breeder flocks, thus developing protective maternal immunity that is transferred to progeny chicks via the yolk sac.
Dosage	0.2 mL/breeder
Vaccination	The vaccine can be administered to breeders from 6 weeks of age onwards. To make sure that adequate antibody levels are present before laying commences, breeders need to be vaccinated at least 6 weeks before the onset of lay.
Method of Administration	For intramuscular or subcutaneous injection. Reconstitute the vaccine in sterile Phosphate Buffered Saline (PBS) diluent. Select the amount of diluent to be used based on the number of doses per vial (200 mL per 1000 doses). Mix well by gentle shaking. The vaccine should be used within 4 hours after reconstitution.
Withholding Period	Zero (0) days
Presentation	Boxes of vials each containing 500 and 1000 doses.
Storage	Store below 8°C in the dark. The vaccine can be stored in a freezer.
Contraindications	None
Disposal	Dispose of surplus by burning or boiling vial and dropper bottle. Discarded needles/sharps should be placed in a designated and appropriately labelled 'sharps' container.
Safety Instructions	If accidental self-inoculation occurs, seek medical advice. Additional information is contained in the Safety Data Sheet.
