

Nobilis® EDS



Vaccine	Nobilis® EDS is an inactivated vaccine against Egg Drop Syndrome (EDS) '76
Target Species	Chicken Breeders and Egg Layers
Composition	Active Components: Inactivated EDS '76 virus strain BC14 inducing $\geq 6.5 \log_2$ HI units per dose
Formulation	Oil adjuvant emulsion
Indications	For protection against EDS '76 by vaccinating replacement breeders and replacement egg layers to develop protective levels of antibodies during lay.
Disease	EDS is caused by an adenovirus that can infect hens in lay via the hatching egg or from the hen's environment. Egg production may fail to peak adequately or production drops may occur, particularly in early lay. Egg abnormalities, such as shell-less eggs ('skins') and loss of pigment in brown eggs, are features of the disease.
Dosage	0.5 mL per bird
Vaccination	Replacement breeders and egg layers should be vaccinated intramuscularly or subcutaneously at approximately 16-20 weeks of age, but not less than 4 weeks before the expected onset of lay. Vaccinate healthy birds only.
Method of Administration	Allow the vaccine to reach ambient temperature (15-25°C) before use. Shake the bottle well before and during use. Inject 0.5 mL of vaccine intramuscularly in the thigh or chest muscle or subcutaneously into the lower part of the neck. Use the entire contents of a bottle when first opened within 3 hours. Use sterile injection equipment.
Withholding Period	NIL
Presentation	Bottles containing 500 mL of vaccine sufficient for 1000 doses.
Storage	Store between 2°C and 8°C (Refrigerate. DO NOT FREEZE).
Restraints	Do Not mix with other vaccines
Disposal	Dispose of empty containers by wrapping with paper and putting in garbage. Discarded needles/sharps should be placed in a designated and appropriately labelled 'sharps' container.
Safety Instructions	Should a vaccinator by accident inject him/herself or a bystander, a local reaction may occur. It is recommended the advice of a doctor is sought, that the doctor be advised that the vaccine is in oil emulsion and that this leaflet or a Safety Data Sheet be shown to the doctor.
