

Nobilis® Fowl Pox



Vaccine	Nobilis® Fowl Pox vaccine is a live attenuated vaccine against Fowl Pox (FP)
Target Species	Chicken Breeders, Egg Layers and Turkeys
Composition	Active Components: Living, attenuated strain B/203 Fowl Pox vaccine with 10 ³ TCID ₅₀ per dose
Formulation	Freeze-dried pellet. The vaccine is reconstituted with Phosphate Buffered Saline (PBS)
Indications	For the prevention of Fowl Pox in chickens and turkeys.
Disease	Fowl Pox is caused by a virus that is transmitted by mosquitoes and inhalation. Affected birds have nodules on the exposed skin areas of the face and legs or membranes in the mouth that can interfere with breathing. Mortality, poor growth rate and egg production losses can result.
Dosage	One dose per bird
Vaccination	Wing-web stab in the hatchery or during the rearing period. See label for general directions and reconstitution.
Method of Administration	Vaccination by wing web stab. This procedure involves the inoculation of a small amount of vaccine, reconstituted in PBS, into the outstretched wing web of a young chicken or poult. Vaccine is picked up by the tip of the vaccine applicator when it is immersed in vaccine. Without draining, it is then thrust through the wing web of the bird. The resulting damaged skin becomes infected with the vaccine virus. Infection from the vaccine virus generates protection against clinical disease. Use the vaccine within one hour of reconstitution.
Withholding Period	Meat: Zero (0) days Eggs: Zero (0) days
Presentation	Boxes of vials containing 1000 doses or 2000 doses.
Storage	Store the vaccine below -5°C (freeze).
Contraindications	None
Disposal	Dispose of empty containers by wrapping in paper and putting in garbage. Unused product should be disposed of into an effluent handling system (e.g. septic tank). Discarded needles/sharps should immediately be placed in a designated and appropriately labelled 'sharps' container.
Safety Instructions	If accidental self-inoculation occurs, seek medical advice. Additional information is contained in the Safety Data Sheet.
